First Day of School: Monday, August 28th will be the first day of school for students.

Powerschool Registration

All students are required to be registered in PowerSchool each year prior to the beginning of the school year. This is an annual process that needs to be completed. Please ensure you review all information and update phone numbers, addresses, emails etc.... This will give us the most up to date information in case we need to contact you. As a reminder most of our communication will be through Swift Alert (texts and emails), and if we don't have your updated info, you may miss some important information. This will also allow you to sign permissions for your child to be able to use the internet, go on in district trips etc...
