

Important Info for Parents of Incoming Kindergarten Students

If you (or someone you know) is planning to send your/their child to kindergarten for the 2023-2024 school year, the following are important dates and activities to know about:

Tomorrow: Friday, March 3rd will be our last Pre-K Activity for this year. Please see the flyer on the back of this newsletter for info. We will begin our preregistration for Kindergarten that day. You will also be able to sign up for Kindergarten Screening at MVE as well.

March 3rd, & March 6th-9th from 8a.m.-4p.m. and March 10th from 8am-noon will be Kindergarten registration at MVE. You will also sign up for Kindergarten Screening at the same time.

March 23rd, 5:30-7:00 p.m.: The Bridger Valley Early Childhood Coalition will host an event at MVE. This will be for all preschool age children and parents/gaurdians. There will be food, fun, and educational activities. K registration will also be available.

April 4th & 5th: Kindergarten Screening at Mountain View Elementary
