## Thank You's



## **Important Safety Reminders**

- \* The lane to the South of our school and playground is considered an emergency lane during school hours. While the buses are there, it is a bus lane, and other vehicles should not use this as an exit at that time (at minimum 7:45-8:00 and 3:00-3:25). This lane is never an entrance.
- \* Please utilize our parent loops as often as possible for dropping off or picking up students. This lane is efficient when used correctly. Please use the left lane to exit, and the right lane to drop off/pick up. Please keep moving forward to to fill gaps and exit as soon as safely possible after picking up/dropping off your child. After school, please wait for your child outside of the school. This helps us maintain a secure and safe learning environment through the end of the day.
- \* Doors do not open until 7:45. We ask that whenever possible students not be dropped off before this time.
- \* As much as no one wants to be reminded of this, please ensure your child/ren are dressed appropriately for the weather each day.

## **Powerschool Registration**

As a reminder: Students are required to be registered in PowerSchool each year. This is an annual process that needs to be completed. Please ensure you review all information and update phone numbers, addresses, emails etc.... This will give us the most up to date information in case we need to contact you. As a reminder most of our communication will be through Swift Alert (texts and emails), and if we don't have your updated info, you may miss some important information. As a reminder: Emergency contacts are individuals you would like us to call after we have tried you as the parents/guardians.
